Our shoji are double sided, meaning kumiko (grid pattern) on both sides of the shoji paper for strength and support. The mock-ups below are 36" x 80" shoji doors scaled down. Starred (\*) kumiko patterns cost an additional \$100 to \$200 per shoji depending on design and shoji size. Kumiko patterns without stars are included in the shoji pricing.

### Kumiko Style Sheet - Shoji Designs Inc.

Rectangular shoji may skew, in which case bent springs of bamboo are inserted into the short diagonal to push them back square. There can be substantial artistry in frame design. The kumiko are the fine wooden laths of the screen, and the tsukeko are the heavier members (usually around the edge).
